



Summer Community Worker Position Description

Objective: Green Timbers Covenant Church (GTCC), a multi-cultural, multi-generational, Christ centred community seeks to cultivate God's Values in the world by nurturing a community of disciples committed to building relational bridges into their life circles, the community and the global village. The Summer Community Worker will help the church fulfill this mission by building relational bridges into the community surrounding Green Timbers Church.

Strategic Plan: The position of Summer Community Worker is designed from and will seek to further our pursuit of the following affirmative statements developed over the past year:

- Be a resource for the neighbourhood where we become a neighbourhood centre
- Build a vibrant children's program and youth group through outreach that encourages young people to become leaders in the church and neighbourhood.

Reporting and Supervision: The Summer Community Worker reports directly to the Lead Pastor. The Summer Community Worker communicates and works alongside of other staff, leadership and the congregation to help the church implement the community bridge building aspect of GTCC's mission statement.

Responsibilities: The Summer Community Worker is expected to perform the following duties:

- Develop and carry out outreach, recreational and sports activities/camps for neighbourhood and church community
- Further our partnership with Green Timbers Elementary through programs, activities and relationships
- Schedule and lead activities for children/youth for our church community
- Plan and implement a Back to School Party for the Green Timbers neighbourhood
 - Promote the event
 - Coordinate the collection of items for yard sale
 - Organize games/food/other activities
 - Include other partners in the delivery of the event
 - Build excitement within the church community for participation in the event
- Assist in the coordination of VBS 2014 with Oakland First Covenant
- Represent GTCC in assisting the Surrey Food Bank every other Wednesday as able
- Recruit members and friends of Green Timbers in staffing the events
- Track hours worked on time card and submit for payment

Qualifications: To be eligible for this position, the applicant must be a follower of Christ, have a passion for the church and a desire to see her grow, and an ability to build relationship within the church and the neighbourhood. Current participation in and knowledge of Green Timbers Covenant Church is a plus. Must be able to handle the physical work involved in hosting and participating in planned events.

Terms and Conditions:

- Hours: Approximately 10-40 hours per week as needed.
- Pay & Benefits: Salary is \$14 per hour. Benefits include the employer's portion of MERCs.
- Criminal record check (abstract) and child abuse registry check.
- First Aid Certificate, Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Certificate (Training for certification will be provided).
